### ORDINANCE NO. 2012-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLARKS SUMMIT TO AMEND THE SIGN STANDARDS IN §505 OF THE BOROUGH OF CLARK SUMMIT ZONING ORDINANCE OF AUGUST 29, 2007 (ORDINANCE 2007-03).

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Clarks Summit, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania, by the authority of and pursuant to the provisions of Act of July 31, 1968, P.L. 805, No. 247 of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as reenacted and amended, known and cited as the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code; that the Borough of Clark Summit Zoning Ordinance of AUGUST 29, 2007 (ORDINANCE 2007-03), as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

AMEND §505 TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

#### **505 Signs**

##### **505.2 Definitions (to include)**

Flag: Any fabric, banner, or bunting containing distinctive colors, patterns, or symbols, used as a symbol of a government, political subdivision, or other entity which is mounted on a pole, cable, or rope at one end.

##### **505.10 Commercial and Manufacturing Uses (to include)**

###### **A. Commercial and Manufacturing Use Signs**

###### **7. Flags**

Flags displayed by commercial, manufacturing, industrial, public and semi-public uses, referred to as *business* in this section, shall be subject to the following:

- A. Business Identification - The flag shall identify the business with no other advertising.
- B. Flag Pole - The flag shall be suspended from a pole and the maximum height shall be thirty-six (36) feet.
- C. Area - The maximum area of the **flag shall be twenty-four (24) square feet, however** this shall not apply to the United States Flag or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Flag.
- D. Government Flags - Governmental flags provided for elsewhere in the Ordinance are not restricted by the provisions of this Section.

**SEVERABILITY**

Should any section, subsection, clause, provision or other portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance; the Board of Supervisors having adopted this Ordinance as if such invalid portions had not been included therein.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

**ADOPTION**
