ORDINANCE NO. 2013-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLARKS SUMMIT AMENDING THE BOROUGH'S MOTOR-VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, 1983-5, AT SECTION 15-501.3 THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE "ADOPT-A-METER PARKING PROGRAM," AND PROSCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

By the powers granted to the Borough of Clarks Summit ("the Borough") by the Pennsylvania Borough Code, 53 P.S. 45101 et seq., specifically the power to regulate the streets, 53 P.S. 46202(17), and the power to make and adopt all such ordinances as may be expedient or necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Borough and its finances, and the maintenance of the peace, good government, safety and welfare of the Borough and its trade, commerce and manufactures, 53 P.S. 46202(74), the Borough HEREBY ENACTS the within amending ordinance.

SECTION I. TITLE

This Amending Ordinance shall be known as the "Adopt-A-Meter Parking Program."

SECTION II. POLICY

Pursuant to its authority under 53 P.S. Section 46202(6) to make such regulations as may be necessary for the health, safety, general welfare and convenience, comfort and safety of the Borough and its citizens; pursuant to its authority under 53 P.S. Section 46202(17) to regulate the streets, public squares, common grounds, sidewalks and curbs within the Borough; and pursuant to its authority under 53 P.S. 46202(74) to make and adopt all such ordinances as may be expedient or necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Borough and its finances, along with the maintenance of the peace, good government, safety and welfare of the Borough and its trade, commerce and manufactures, the Borough Council enacts the within amending ordinance known as the "Adopt-A-Meter Parking Program."

SECTION III. SECTION 15-501.3: THE ADOPT-A-METER PARKING PROGRAM

Section 15-501.3

A. No person shall park a vehicle or allow same to remain parked at any parking space specifically labeled as a rented parking space under the Adopt-A-Meter Parking Program unless said person is a customer of the renter business.

B. Local business owners may rent one or more metered parking spaces from those listed herein below through the Borough application process.

C. All rates and fees for renting a metered parking space shall be set and collected pursuant to Resolution, and as periodically updated, of the Borough Council.

D. The Borough shall remove the meter head from the meter of each rented parking space and shall replace said meter head with an appropriate and approved business logo or sign in order to designate the parking space as a rented parking space for customers of the respective renter business.

E. Metered parking spaces subject to this amendment and to the Adopt-A-Meter Parking Program are as follows:

Street/Intersection	Spaces	No. of Spaces at Location
Depot Street	48 through 59	12
	65 through 68	4
State Street	5, 6, 78 through 81	6
Davis Street	88 through 89	2
Main Avenue	25, 26	2

F. If at any time any of the above-listed spaces have not been rented, or are not subject to a renter agreement, under this Section then the respective meter head shall remain in place, or shall be replaced, and normal metered parking restrictions shall apply.

SECTION IV. PENALTIES

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle in violation of the "Adopt-A-Meter Parking Program, and upon conviction of same in a summary proceeding before a Magisterial District Judge shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$ 35.00. Each day's violation shall be deemed a separate offense. AFTER 10 DAYS RAISED TO \$ 50.00

SECTION V. SEVERABILITY AND AMENDMENT

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this amending ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of the within amending ordinance so long as same remains workable minus the invalid portion.


SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately.


