HANDICAPPED PARKING ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 04 OF 2017

AN ORDINANCE OF CLARKS SUMMIT BOROUGH ESTABLISHING A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE AT ALL TIMES IN FRONT OF 500 SCHOOL ST IN THE BOROUGH OF CLARKS SUMMIT AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

Clarks Summit Borough Council hereby ordains:

Section 1. The following is established as a special purpose parking zone, and it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle or to allow it to remain parked, except as specifically provided for:

Street	Side	Location	Authorized Purpose for vehicle
School Street	West	500 School Street	Discharge and pickup of Handicapped person(s)

Section 2. Ticketing of Vehicles Parked Unlawfully.

1. It shall be the duty of the police officers and/or parking enforcement personnel of the Clark Summit Borough, to issue a parking citation for vehicles parked unlawfully in the aforementioned prohibited parking zones.

Section 3. Penalty for Violation. Any person who violates any provision of the prohibited Parking Ordinance shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50.00 and costs.


Section 4. Repealer. Any Resolution, Ordinance or part of any Ordinance or Resolution inconsistent herewith and any amendments thereof are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they affect this Ordinance.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The Borough reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Resolution and the effective administration thereof.


Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.

Section 7. Authority. This Ordinance is enacted by the Council of the Borough of Clarks Summit under the authority of the Act of Legislature, February 1, 1966, P.L. (1965) No. 581 Section 1005, as amended 1979, November 2, P.L. 458 No. 94, 53 P.S. Section 46005, et seq., known as the Borough Code and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


